MINUTES OF THE MEETING :

1. The BOS members interacted with the subject experts in detail and suggested to incorporate some new subjects and modifications in the syllabus for some subjects.
2. It suggested by them to remove the elective **Pulse and Switching Circuits** and to incorporate **Python Programming** for the benefit of the students in the 5th Semester.
3. It is suggested to offer **Analog and Digital Communications** as elective instead of compulsory subject in 3rd year 5th semester.
4. It is suggested to include HPLC and Chromatography in the Analytical instrumentation Syllabus.
5. It is suggested to shift the course **Digital Image Processing** elective from 8th Semester to 7th Semester.

7. One of the board members suggested, include industry related topics which are useful to the students when they go out.
8. As per the request from the HOD English department and for the convenience the **subjects Biology for Engineers (18CE002) and Technical English (18EL002)** positions were interchanged in the scheme in the 2nd year 4th semester.
9. Finally, R18 syllabus for 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Semesters was finalized and approved with few modifications and suggestions.
